

ROSLING KING JOINS WW1 COMMEMORATION (Issued on behalf of Rosling King LLP)

London 3rd October 2014 - Rosling King, the legal firm specialising in serving the needs of banks, financial institutions, corporations and the property market, has joined the commemoration of the start of World War 1 at a reception in the City of London.

Rosling King is presenting guests and staff with 400 poppies that are part of the 'Blood Swept Lands and Seas of Red' installation at the Tower of London.

The installation will conclude on November 11th to coincide with Armistice Day and shortly after that each guest who has attended the reception and each member of RK staff will be receiving one of the scarlet ceramic poppies carefully crafted by volunteers.
